

Spend Steve Snyder's money

Attorney Stephen L. Snyder — he of the \$2.5 million grant to **United Cerebral Palsy** and \$1 million endowment to establish the **Stephen L. Snyder Litigation Skills Center** at the **University of Baltimore School of Law** — is at it again.

But this time, you, yes you, will determine just how much he drops in the bucket. Two buckets, actually.

Flanked by Attorney General J. Joseph Curran Jr. and Mayor Martin O'Malley in the ceremonial room of Baltimore's City Hall, Snyder plans to announce this morning his dollar-for-dollar match challenge to the legal community in support of the **Center for Poverty Solutions' Lawyers' Campaign** against Hunger and the **College Bound Foundation's Annual Lawyers' Campaign**.

"He's long been involved with the **Lawyers' Campaign Against Hunger**," said Snyder's law partner Mark Kopec. "I've been involved with both, and called his attention to the **College Bound** campaign. We thought it was a natural

match, given his commitment to education."

So how much is this going to set Snyder back?

Last year, the **College Bound** lawyers' campaign raised about \$90,000 while the **Lawyers' Campaign Against Hunger** raised about \$130,000, Kopec said.
