

# Continuing tradition: Steven L. Snyder sponsor's JDF's Golf Classic

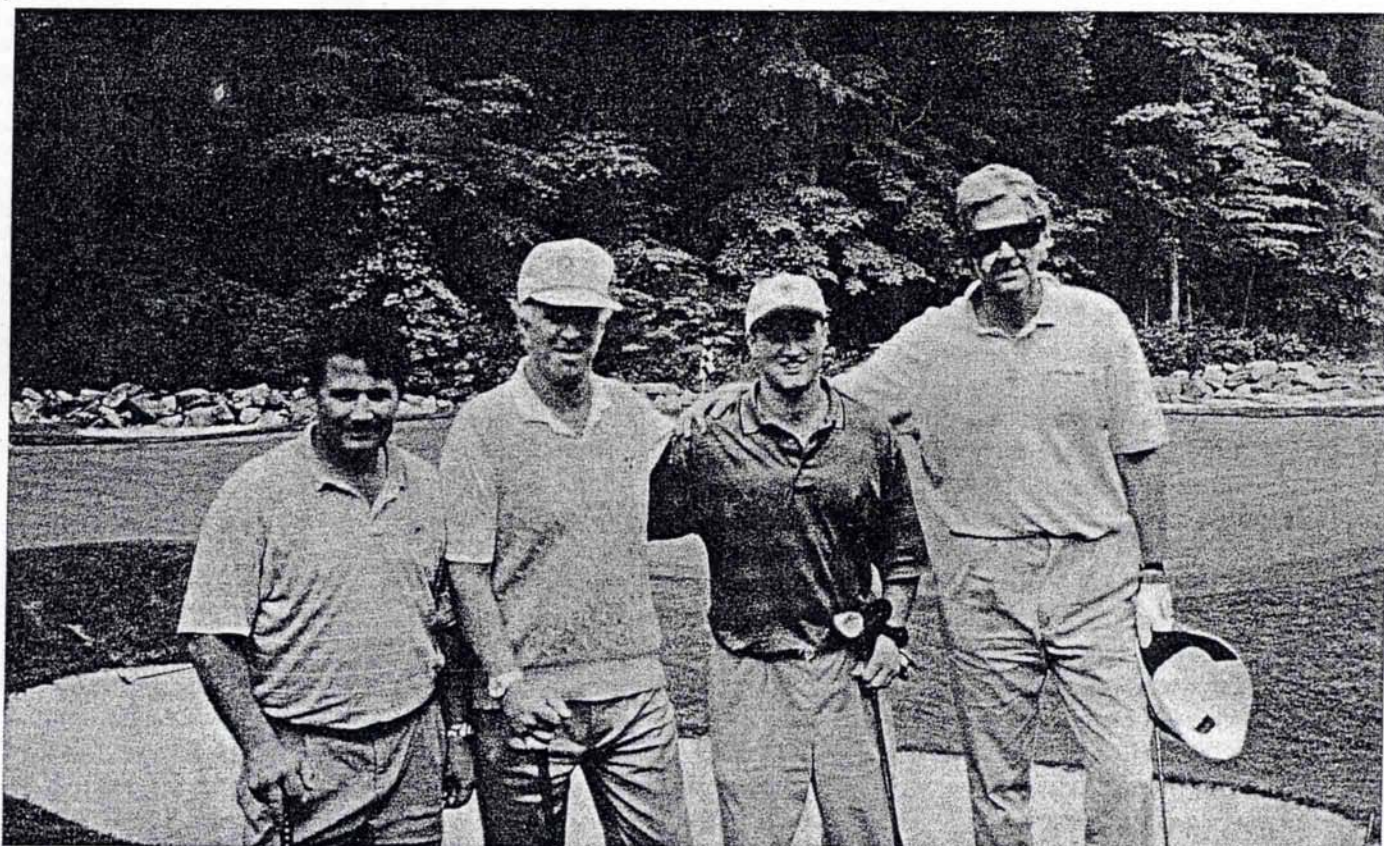
Building on the achievement of the record-breaking 1999 Juvenile Diabetes Golf Classic, this year's outing will again be held at the world-class 18-hole course at the Bulle Rock Country Club in Harford County. Scheduled for Wednesday, May 17, the 9th annual Golf Classic is chaired by Robyn Mingle and Mike O'Malley, employees of Black & Decker's North America Power Tools and Accessories Division.

"I joined forces with JDF because we are so close to developing a cure for juvenile diabetes," said Mingle. "Proceeds from the golf outing will continue to bridge our efforts to eliminate this horrible disease." Participating in the event, she stressed, will give everyone the knowledge that they are part of the solution to winning the battle against the disease.

Last year, the Golf Classic raised a record \$93,000 to help JDF in

its mission to discover a cure for diabetes and its complications. The Juvenile Diabetes Foundation has raised \$350 million for research, more than any other non-governmental agency in the world.

This year the golf committee projects an even greater success. Steven L. Snyder has again agreed to be the Presenting Sponsor. Black and Decker and Mercantile Bank are Gold Sponsors and to date KCI Technologies is the first JDF Silver Sponsor.
